

- Webster University in Georgia is accepting applications until July 20, 2022 (deadline for students who need a visa to reside in Georgia is June 15, 2022)
- To apply to Webster University Georgia for a master's degree, you will need to:
 - Document undergraduate degree completion: bachelor's diploma
 - Demonstrate a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent
 - Demonstrate English proficiency at a level equal to or higher than IELTS 6.0.

GRADUATE TUITION FEES
