# **UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS START IN FALL 2022 — AUGUST 22**

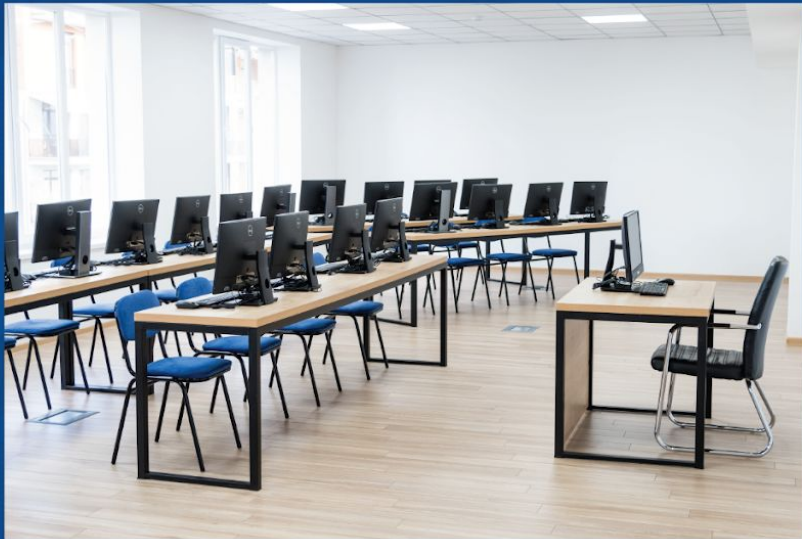
- **Webster University in Georgia is accepting applications until Aug. 1, 2022 (deadline for students who need a visa to reside in Georgia is July 4, 2022)**
- **To apply to Webster University Georgia for a bachelor's degree, you will need to:**
  - Document school completion: school leaving diploma
  - Demonstrate a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent
  - Demonstrate English proficiency at a level equal to or higher than IELTS 6.0.



# **GRADUATE PROGRAMS START IN FALL 2022 — AUGUST 15**

- **Webster University in Georgia is accepting applications until July 20, 2022 (deadline for students who need a visa to reside in Georgia is June 15, 2022)**
- **To apply to Webster University Georgia for a master's degree, you will need to:**
  - Document undergraduate degree completion: bachelor's diploma
  - Demonstrate a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent
  - Demonstrate English proficiency at a level equal to or higher than IELTS 6.0.







# TUITION FEES & POLICIES

## UNDERGRADUATE TUITION FEES

- The annual tuition fee for the Academic Year of 2022-2023 is \$8,900, for all International Students

## GRADUATE TUITION FEES

- The annual tuition fee for the Academic Year of 2022-2023 is \$9,600, for all International Students.

*The fee can be paid in halves at the beginning of each semester.  
Payment is made in Georgian Lari based on the National Bank of Georgia rate.*
